All metered street parking is free on Saturdays in the city of Coatesville. Free parking is also available at the following lots:

- Lots next to and across from City Hall except police lot
- Lots along Third Avenue between Lincoln and Harmony streets
- Lot at Third and Maple Avenue
- Lot next to Coatesville Flower Shop on Lincoln Highway between Second and Third avenues (enter from the west on Diamond Street)
- Lot at First Avenue and Lincoln Highway next to old First Niagara Bank
- There is ample street parking on Lincoln Highway, Harmony Street and Third Avenue (except where police will mark off on Harmony for the food vendors).

NOTE: Kersey Street will be closed from Third to Fourth Avenue.
